



Saddleback College Matriculation Process

All students who are required to complete the Matriculation process will need to complete all three of the following steps before registering for classes.

Online Orientation, go to www.saddleback.edu/matriculation and click on the Online Orientation button. You will need to complete all six sections of the orientation.

Assessment testing in Math, English, and Reading are conducted by appointment in the Matriculation testing room located in the Student Services Center room 225-A. Please call 949-582-4970 to schedule an appointment.

Group Advisement sessions help students to determine their educational goal, plan a first semester schedule, and prepare a "Student Educational Plan".
The Group Advisement session occurs after the student completes the assessment testing session or evaluation of Alternative Evidence. Appointments for Group Advisements are made at the Matriculation office SSC 225-B or by calling 949-582-4970. You may also enroll in APSY 1, APSY 140, or APSY 160 to fulfill your Group Advisement requirement.



Register For Classes after you have completed all three steps of the Matriculation process. You will be eligible to register for classes on your assigned date. Instructions on how to register and pay for classes are published in the Saddleback College Schedule of Classes and also appears on MySite.
