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10. NEW BUSINESS

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A. ATEP Senator

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Taylor Brooks and Morgan Barrows brought this idea to Senate. The proposal is to create a new senator at large that will represent the satellite instructional location at ATEP. This change will require a bylaw changes. ATEP should be opening in May and will be at full schedule in the Fall. It is a 19-mile drive from Saddleback so the request is that this member be able to attend Academic Senate meetings virtually from their satellite campus at a fixed location to meet Brown Act requirements. These are two separate items: (1) Do we want a new ATEP senator and (2) should we allow the representative the option to attend remotely from the satellite campus?

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This will come back since this requires a change in Senate bylaws.

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B. Dissolving Honors Board as a Senate Committee

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Margot Lovett shared that the Honors Board was created as a standing Senate Committee over 20 years ago when the college administration was not in favor of honors courses. Creating this Board was a way to protect honors and keep them under the purview of the Academic Senate. This is no longer the case and our honors program/courses are flourishing.
